

## How to withdraw money from crypto Ledger? By new wallet

Withdrawing money from your Ledger **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** isn't about pulling cash directly out of the device itself—the Ledger simply secures your private keys. Instead, you'll need to **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** move your cryptocurrency to an exchange where it can be sold for fiat money like USD or EUR. Start by opening Ledger Live, your device's companion **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** app. Connect your Ledger hardware, navigate to the "Portfolio" tab, and select the cryptocurrency you wish to withdraw. **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** Click "Send," and you'll be asked to paste an address—this is where the exchange comes in. To get that address, log into a trusted exchange like **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** Coinbase, Kraken, or Binance. Go to your fiat wallet or "Receive" section, choose the exact same cryptocurrency you're sending from your **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** Ledger, and copy the deposit address provided. Paste this address carefully into Ledger Live, double-checking the first and last few characters to **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** avoid errors. Enter the amount you want to withdraw, then confirm the transaction on your physical Ledger device by pressing **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** the button. The blockchain will process the transfer, which usually takes a few minutes to an hour. Once your crypto arrives in the exchange wallet, you can **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** sell it for cash. Head to the exchange's "Trade" or "Sell" page, choose your crypto pair (e.g., BTC/USD), and execute **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** the sale. After selling, the funds become fiat currency in your exchange account. **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** Always remember to send a small test amount first, especially if you're new to the process—it's a friendly **+1 888.590.9448 (US)** habit that saves major headaches. Your Ledger keeps your crypto safe, but moving it to an exchange is the bridge to real-world money.
